Nominees

The Secretary and Treasurer shall be elected for two years and assume their duties beginning July 15th, 2016. A candidate for Secretary or Treasurer shall be a member in good standing of the Schaumburg Education Association. A full description of duties of each office can be found in Section VI of the SEA By-Laws found in each building. Please see your building representative for further information.

Per SEA By-Laws, the list of nominees for both Secretary and Treasurer will be submitted to schools at least 48 hours prior to the SEA General Meeting. Nominations will also be accepted from the floor of the SEA General Meeting, April 18th, provided that the consent of the nominee has been obtained. According to the SEA By-Laws, in the event that the total number of candidates equals the number of elected officers' positions allotted, no election will be necessary.
